

Follow-up Request

1. Officer Vladic's RATF:
There is no RATF. When Officer Vladic activated his WatchGuard it went back to the approx. same time as Officer Nelson's, Bickford's, & Officer Grommes RATF so no RATF was performed for Officer Vladic.
2. Sergeant Hoeger WatchGuard/RATF:
There is no WatchGuard or RATF. Sergeant Hoeger responded after the incident/shooting had occurred and provided scene security so WatchGuard was not required.
3. Officer DeNio WatchGuard/RATF:
There is no WatchGuard or RATF. Officer DeNio responded after the incident/shooting had occurred to assist in the follow-up investigation with detectives so WatchGuard was not required.
4. Officer Kirkpatrick & Officer Bishop were not working on the night in question.
Officer Kirkpatrick shared a patrol car with Officer Bickford in 2020. Officer Kirkpatrick was on days off so Officer Bickford was utilizing their assigned patrol car.
Officer Bishop shared a patrol car with Officer Grommes in 2020. Officer Bishop was on days off so Officer Grommes was utilizing their assigned patrol car.
5. Evidence #27, #39, & # 53:
#27 evidence tag was invalidated & #28 evidence tag was tagged to the evidence. After printing evidence tag #27 an error was discovered so a new tag was created (#28) & assigned to the evidence.
#39 evidence was a bicycle that was returned to the owner
#53 evidence tag was invalidated & #54 evidence tag was tagged to the evidence. After printing evidence tag #53 an error was discovered so a new tag was created (#54) & assigned to the evidence.
6. Results of evidence submission form both DNA & guns:
See attached forms. The guns were initially sent to the lab to be matched with the ammo recovered @ the scene. A request was then made for blood, DNA, & fingerprints on the Taurus pistol. Lab was only able to test for blood & not DNA/fingerprints. A test for DNA/fingerprints could not be conducted due to the first test; matching the ammo to the guns (firearm/tool mark).

If dispatch hears from an officer or communication from that officer before the time expires the dispatch will perform a "timer override"

11. Cole's name not added to the incident report per the officer's request:
Officer Boeckel (390) had not positively identified Stump at the hospital and was still in the process of a positive ID when he learned of the name, Cole Stump. Officer Boeckel did not want Stump's name in the report @ that time in case Stump was not the person in question.

***GPS-Locating an officer can be done in real time. However, the BPD does not log/store GPS history. The financial burden to maintain that data is too expensive.

RESULTS AND CONCLUSIONS:

Item 2 is a Glock brand 9mm Luger pistol, model 17Gen4, serial number BERM519. It is a mechanically functional firearm as received in the laboratory. It was test fired using ammunition from the laboratory supply. The test fired bullets and cartridge cases will be returned with the other items of evidence. It was received with no magazine.

Item 3 is a Glock brand 9mm Luger pistol with an aftermarket Agency Arms brand slide, serial number BHBM312. It is a mechanically functional firearm as received in the laboratory. It was test fired using ammunition from the laboratory supply. The test fired bullets and cartridge cases will be returned with the other items of evidence. It was received with no magazine.

Item 4 is a Taurus brand 9mm Luger pistol, model G2c, serial number TLY19108. It is a mechanically functional firearm as received in the laboratory. It was test fired using ammunition from the laboratory supply. The test fired bullets and cartridge cases will be returned with the other items of evidence. It was received with no magazine.

Items 5, 6, 7, 8 ,9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 are ten fired Federal brand 9mm Luger cartridge cases, one fired Sellier & Bellot brand 9mm Luger cartridge case and one fired Fiocchi brand 9mm Luger cartridge case. They were all compared to each other and to the test fired cartridge cases from Items 2, 3, and 4 (pistols).

Based on agreement of all discernible class characteristics and corresponding individual detail in the firing pin aperture shear marks and firing pin marks, Items 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 were identified as having been fired by Item 3 (pistol).

Based on agreement of all discernible class characteristics and corresponding individual detail in the firing pin

aperture shear marks, Items 11, 12, 13 and 14 were identified as having been fired by Item 2 (pistol).

Based on agreement of all discernible class characteristics and a disagreement of individual detail in the firing pin aperture shear marks (Items 2 and 3) along with a disagreement of all discernible class characteristics (Items 4 and 16), Item 15 can be eliminated as having been fired by Items 2, 3, and 4 or having been fired by the same firearm that fired Item 16.

Based on agreement of all discernible class characteristics and a disagreement of individual detail in the firing pin aperture shear marks (Item 4) along with a disagreement of all discernible class characteristics (Items 2, 3 and 15), Item 16 can be eliminated as having been fired by Items 2, 3, and 4 or having been fired by the same firearm that fired Item 15.

Comments: The identification of a cartridge(s) and/or bullet(s) is made to a practical, not absolute, exclusion of all other firearms. It is not possible to examine all firearms which is a prerequisite for absolute certainty. Sufficient agreement for an identification exists between firearm produced toolmarks when the likelihood another firearm could have fired the cartridge case(s) and or bullet(s) is so remote as to be considered a practical impossibility.

When "debris" is reported, it may include a wide variety of material outside the scope of identification by the Montana State Crime Lab. These materials may include, but are not limited to; dirt, shavings, detritus, and fragments of unknown origin that appear foreign to the item analyzed.

Sexual assault kits screened for the presence of male DNA were done so using a direct lysis method followed by a qPCR quantification method. Items reported as inconclusive for indications of male DNA are due to the detected quantity of male DNA falling below established laboratory thresholds.
